INSTRUCTIONS

Your completed application package should include all of the following items:

1. Completed graduate application
2. \$20 application fee
3. An official transcript from each institution attended sent directly to the appropriate admissions office. For transcripts in languages other than English, please provide a certified English translation with an explanation of the grading system.
4. Standardized test scores when required—please check the *Graduate Bulletin* for requirements. International students must also take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), scoring 550 or higher (213 or higher computer-based), unless their previous degree is from a college or university in which the language of instruction is English.
5. The appropriate numbers of letters of recommendation for your specific program. The Department of Education requires three letters of recommendation; all other programs require two. The Department of Education will provide a form for the recommender to complete.
6. A résumé of work experiences and a statement of educational purpose
7. The Department of Education requires applicants to take the Miller Analogies Test (MAT), submit a writing sample, and schedule a personal interview. Details concerning these requirements can be addressed by calling the Department of Education at (504) 864-7840.

DEADLINES

The Department of Communications has established a November 1 deadline for spring admission and a July 1 deadline for fall admission. Summer admission is not available in the Department of Communications.

The Department of Education has established a December 1 deadline for spring, a May 1 deadline for summer, and an August 1 deadline for fall admission. Applicants must also take the Miller Analogies Test by November 1 for spring, April 1 for summer, and July 1 for fall admission.

Admission to the Graduate Division does not guarantee the applicant admission to a degree program. For detailed requirements for admission to each degree program, refer to the current *Graduate Bulletin*.

For Juris Doctorate combined programs, the applicant must also apply separately to the School of Law. Call (504) 861-5575 for more information.

Applicants who are not certified but are applying for the Master of Science in Teaching Mathematics Program must also be accepted by the Department of Education.

Graduate courses are available to non-degree-seeking students on a limited basis. Please contact the Office of Admissions for more information.
